Greetings Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Advent and Christmas blessings be with each of you!

Here are a few words about our Advent and Christmas season worship series that we have been using from *A Sanctified Art.*

When something hits close to home, it affects us deeply. During the Advent and Christmas season, we jour-

ney through scriptures and rituals that are tender, heavy with emotion, and vulnerable. We carry the memories and truths of this season close to our hearts. The Close to Home theme acknowledges the "already but not yet" tension of our faith: Emmanuel is with us, and yet, God's promised day—our everlasting home—is not fully realized. It names our deep longing for God to come close to us. The Advent and Christmas scriptures are rich with home metaphors and imagery. In these scriptures, home is both physical and metaphorical, something we seek and something we are called to build. In many ways, these scriptures are like blueprints detailing the dreams of a God who makes a home with us. Ultimately, God is our home and resting place. God draws near and makes a home on earth; sacred ground is all around us.

This Advent, may we be comforted by the One who dwells intimately with us. May we expand safety and sanctuary for everyone wandering far from home. May we come home—wherever home is found—to live fully with joy, hope, and courage.

Dear Church Family,

Thank you for joining me for my first recital at Speedway this past Sunday! It was a joy to share some of my favorite Advent and Christmas tunes with you. Musically speaking, the season of Advent is the richest of the

year for a church musician. Organists for the last 500 years have been improvising and composing pieces on Advent and Christmas tunes. A large portion of Bach's surviving organ music is preludes on Advent hymns from the Lutheran tradition. My favorite, and the piece I started my recital with, is a prelude on the hymn *Nun komm, der Heiden Heiland* (Savior of the Nations Come). This



hymn was sung the first Sunday of Advent in German churches during the 18th century and Bach wrote 4 different organ settings of it. We think of his organ compositions today as "concert" music, but they were really improvisations. Bach improvised on hymn tunes every Sunday at his church in Leipzig – many of his organ pieces are simply written down improvisations. I've tried to model my approach to church music in this way.

I look forward to beginning the new year in ministry at Speedway. This community is already special to me in many ways, but it is now the first church that my husband and I attend together as a married couple, and I could not think of a better place to serve. I wish you all a joy-filled Christmas and a happy new year!
