Greetings Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

For the last several years, May has been a little bit different for me. Growing up as a central Indiana kid, May was really just a lead up to the *greatest spectacle in racing* culminating with heading over to my grandparents' house and LISTENING to the race. My great-grandma would already be there, diligently cutting out the drivers names from the Indianapolis Star newspaper. We would then have the opportunity to *buy race cars*, hoping that this would be the year that our driver would win! Awards were given out for first out (normally from a crash or mechanical failure) and then for the driver that came in first, second and third place at the race. The house would be filled with my great-grandma's voice asking those who were listening closely *was that a wreck, or who's leading now?* If it was a hot end of May, we would often find ourselves cooling off in the pool and just generally enjoying each other's company. Grandma's moto was always *once you are invited, you are always invited.*



My great-grandma has been gone now for several years as have many people who once were a part of the fun of race day. During my time in Southern Indiana, it was often a challenge to head north for a day or two at the end of May, and try as I might, there was just never the same *feel* for *The Race* in that portion of the state. Folks tended to get more excited about the Mint Julips and big hats of the Kentucky Derby (not enough horse power for me). Also, you could watch the race on TV, which I never got used to.

But this May, it will be different! I can *hear* and *feel* the cars practicing on the track as I write these words. And even though we won't have in person worship on race day, we will gather together for worship on **Thursday, May 29 @ 6:45pm**. I am thankful for what will surely be an abundance of new memories. I am thankful that in our own ways, we are invited to come home. For me, that means I get to come home to my roots. My prayer is that you too, will come home and experience all the wonderful things at work here at Speedway Christian Church.
